Configuring Outlook Express to download e-mail

- 1) Start Outlook Express
- 2) Click on the "Tools" menu and then click on "Accounts"
- 3) Click the "Add" button and then select "Mail" option
- 4) Select the "Display name" as your name
- 5) Click on "Next"
- 6) Enter the email address allotted to you
- 7) Click on "Next"
- 8) Enter the "Incoming mail server" as the POP3 server name provided
- 9) Enter the "Outgoing mail server" as the SMTP server name provided
- 10) Click on "Next"
- 11) Provide the account name as per the username allotted for this account
- 12) Provide the password as per the password allotted for this account
- 13) Make sure that the "Save password" option is ticked
- 14) Click on "Next"
- 15) Click on "Finish"
- 16) Next double click the newly created account to open its properties
- 17) Click on the "Servers" tab and enable the "My server requires authentication" option
- 18) Click on "OK" to close the box and then "OK" again to close the "Internet Accounts" dialog box

Whenever you want to check for e-mail, make sure you are connected to the Internet and then run Outlook Express and select the "Send and Receive" button on the toolbar.
